Even though we have had significant snowfall this last winter, we must always be diligent in preventing wildfires. Here are some precautions to keep in mind:

- Use approved fire pits only with a source of water readily available.
- Thoroughly douse all fires built in approved fire pits. Never leave them unattended. Adult supervision is required for fires.
- No incendiary targets at the firing range.
- The firing range may be closed if fire danger is high. Also, fires in approved pits may be prohibited. Notices will be posted.

- All UTV's, 4 Wheelers, and Motorcycles MUST have a lot tag attached. If you don't have one, please purchase one from the caretaker. This applies to your visitors as well.
- The State of Utah requires all ATVs/UTVs to have a license plate and all drivers to have completed the driving/safety course. You can access the course here.
