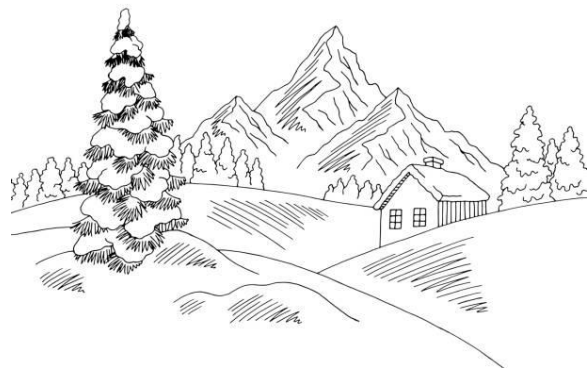
Calendar:

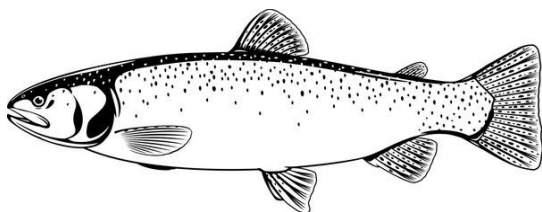
Remember, discharge of fireworks is not allowed at any time in Uintalands.
